Dear Professor Ramic,

Thank you for your email of 6 March to the Secretary of State for Defence about targets being purchased for the British Army Training Unit Suffield. I have been asked to reply.

I am sure you will appreciate that targets need to provide our soldiers with realistic situational and decision making training. A mixture of ethnic appearances has been purchased to provide our trainers with the ability to replicate situations where enemy combatants are mixed with friendly forces, indigenous forces, local population and refugees.

The targets concerned are commercially available products for which the catalogue names is a matter for the company concerned. You will, however, be pleased to know that the British Army use a non-specific geopolitical scenario and no assumptions are made between the catalogue names and the geography of the UK's operational activity. The catalogue name of the target in question will not, therefore, be used as part of the training undertaken by British troops in Canada.
